The achieved (business) certificate of professional competence is your proof of an employee who meets the requirements according to the Scaffolding directive.

During the training, the following components will be dealt with:

- Assessing and releasing of the strength, rigor and stability of standard scaffolds on the basis of drawings;
- Inspecting scaffold material on the basis of actual criteria and standards;
- Inspecting and assessing the safety of scaffolds in all stages;
- Signaling corrective measurements;
- Providing insight into corrective and/or relative constructive materials through sketches;
- Legal and liability aspects of scaffolding.
